

Naloxone Skills Session Equipment

The following equipment recommendations are based on class sizes of 8 students. You must obtain additional equipment for larger classes.

- No AV equipment is necessary.
- You must have at least one manikin or airway head with accessible nasal passages. Your local hospital or ambulance service may have ones you can borrow.
- You must have at least one of each type of training device (one nasal spray, one nasal atomizer, one auto-injector).
- If students have them available, they should bring a trainer pocket mask or barrier device to class with them.

Paperwork

- You must have one roster for each separate training sessions. For documentation purposes, rosters may not be combined.
- Skill checklists: You must have at least one per student. It is recommended to have multiples available for each student so that there is enough for student reference, remediation, and extras for the students to take with them.
- At least one copy of each type of device instructions. (Extras are recommended.)
- Evaluations: Students must fill out an evaluation of the overall training at the conclusion of each hands-on skill session.
- One set of scenarios for each instructor.

Additional Items Necessary for Master Trainer Sessions

- At least one “kit” with each type of device per master trainer.
- Instructions for directing students to website for online module & entering rosters.
- Paperwork packet that includes the paperwork listed above
